

Job Announcement:
CERTIFICATION MANAGER

The City of Oakwood is currently accepting applications for the position of Certification Manager. This position is responsible for developing policy and procedures, building programs, managing processes, and directing the department's efforts to attain and maintain Certification under the Georgia Law Enforcement Certification Program. Under the department's organizational structure, this position reports directly to the Chief of Police.

The position is open to candidates that are either certified law enforcement officers (sworn) or to candidates that are not sworn officers. The basic qualifications for the position include a minimum of 6 years of law enforcement experience with a good background. Candidates will also be required to participate in the departmental selection process, which includes truth verification testing, fingerprinting and completion of a criminal history query at a minimum. Prior experience in supervision or management as well as a college degree is preferred, but not required.
